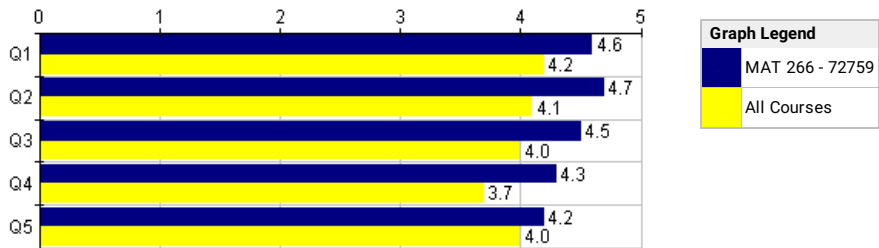

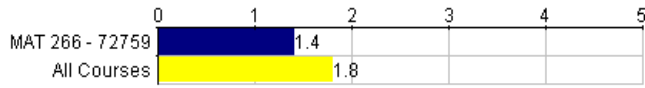
Response Rate: 72.22% (13 of 18)

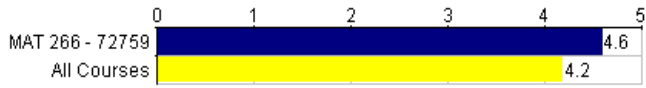
